Director of Operations

Operations and Administrator update was provided by Kyle Seidel and Pete Trombley.

EGLE Letter Regarding Transfer Station Inspection

In the board packet is the Michigan Department of Environmental, Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE) report of the inspection at the transfer station. Mr. Seidel reported a response has been sent to EGLE on September 8, 2022 addressing all the issues. Mr. Seidel explained the SEMSD staff has been at the transfer station cleaning the grounds. Mr. Binson suggested to make a weekly schedule for the SEMSD staff to come out and clean. Campo delivered a \$95,000.00 check this week.

Mr. Trombley stated a fire occurred at the transfer station this afternoon. It was one of the transport trailers. The SMDA staff started with hosing down the fire out then the Roseville Fire Department responded and made sure the fire was out.

Everly Access Agreement

At Site 9/9a, 24 Mile and Foss in Macomb Township the Every of Macomb is building a subdivision on the property adjacent to the landfill and according to the consent decree with EGLE the SMDA is required to have offsite monitoring wells. This agreement will allow the SMDA access to the property to monitor the wells and conduct certain work as defined in Section "C" in the access agreement. Mr. Tomlinson stated he had gone back and forth and reached an agreement on the language. One time \$2,500 fee. Mr. Tomlinson recommends approving the Everly Access Agreement as presented.
