a. Transfer Station Financial Update - Mr. Walby provided the Transfer Station Financial Update. The total net profit after expenses is \$253,364.47. The MSW tonnage was up. We should start to see Compost coming in starting March 27, 2026. Outstanding payments are going well; we are still working with Express and Standard Waste. Priority payment has been within 38 days, showing significant progress since new management has come in.

Mr. Walby stated we had some significant wind damage occur at the Transfer Station during the past month and will have some quotes coming in for the repairs. We have also had extra manpower there as well due to the wind for clean up and debris pick up.
